Julebukking in Petersburg -

Christmas, the residents of Petersburg, Alaska affirm the town's nickname, "Little Norway," by keeping alive a centuries-old Scandinavian holiday

In the days leading up to tradition known as Julebukking.

> Julebukking's roots stretch deep into Norse history, predating Christianity. The tradition's name derives from the Norwe

gian "julebukk," meaning "Yule goat," a symbol connected to the Norse god Thor, whose chariot was pulled by two goats. In ancient times, young men would dress in goatskins

and go door-to-door, performing pranks and demanding food and drink - a practice that some scholars believe may have connections to Thor's legends.

As Christianity spread through Scandinavia, the tradition evolved. The wild revelry of ancient times transformed into a more community-oriented celebration, though it retained its playful spirit. In Norway, Julebukking became a Christmas season tradition where people would dress in costumes, wear masks, and go house to house, singing songs and receiving treats.

In Petersburg, near Christmas but especially concentrated on Christmas Eve, many local businesses and organizations open their doors and welcome community members and visitors with each establishment offering its own unique spread of food and drink.

Retails spaces serve as cozy gathering spots, like on Saturday when the front office of the Petersburg Pilot dished out a few hundred cups of Barszcz or borscht, Polish beet soup -

courtesy of the Pilot's press operator Aleksandra Richards who grew up in Poland near the border of Ukraine. Richards noted that this year's Barszcz used every available beet on the island was influenced by Ukrainian recipes.

The Petersburg Vikings and Valkyries donned their leather and furs on Saturday and lavished libation and cheer on everybody passing near their bus parked close to the Harbor

On Sunday, traditional Petersburg Norske treats like lefse, krumkake, sandbakkel sugar cookies, almond puff, meatballs and more populated the tremendous potluck spread at the Sons of Norway Hall.

And the early hosts were just the beginning. Through late afternoon on Christmas Eve another dozen downtown julebukking venues will celebrate their past year and their appreciation for the community's support in year to come by sharing their food and drink and cheer.

forgotten almost every other song. But when those notes hit my ears the rest of my body remembers, and my fingers tap it out as muscle memory. Catching myself in the habit one day left me curious about its history.

The song "Carol of the Bells," as we know it in English, was written by Peter Silhousky, with the lyrical copyright secured in 1936. But the iconic melody was initially written by Ukrainian composer Mykola Leontovych in 1914, titled "Shchedryk." Based on a traditional Ukrainian folk chant, the lyrics follow a sparrow as it flies into a household singing of bountiful promises the new year will have for the family.

The song made its international debut in 1919 as the nation of Ukraine sough support for its independence, which was being fought by the Soviet government. Eventually, in 1922, the song made its way to the United States for a sold out show in Carnegie Hall. The rest, as they say, is history.

Leontovych didn't get to see his song make its way around the world. He was killed by a Soviet agent in 1919, as part of the wave of repression against Ukrainian political and cultural figures. But he left us his promise of spring, and a melody hypnotic enough to help us find the light on even the darkest of days. As the light returns, so will the feathered heralds of spring, singing their sacred song.



peace, goodwill toward men." Luke 2:14



And as sunrises come, and as sunsets depart,



forgotten almost every other song. But when those notes hit my ears the rest of my body remembers, and my fingers tap it out as muscle memory. Catching myself in the habit one day left me curious about its history.

The song "Carol of the Bells," as we know it in English, was written by Peter Silhousky, with the lyrical copyright secured in 1936. But the iconic melody was initially written by Ukrainian composer Mykola Leontovych in 1914, titled "Shchedryk." Based on a traditional Ukrainian folk chant, the lyrics follow a sparrow as it flies into a household singing of bountiful promises the new year will have for the family.

The song made its international debut in 1919 as the nation of Ukraine sough support for its independence, which was being fought by the Soviet government. Eventually, in 1922, the song made its way to the United States for a sold out show in Carnegie Hall. The rest, as they say, is history.

Leontovych didn't get to see his song make its way around the world. He was killed by a Soviet agent in 1919, as part of the wave of repression against Ukrainian political and cultural figures. But he left us his promise of spring, and a melody hypnotic enough to help us find the light on even the darkest of days. As the light returns, so will the feathered heralds of spring, singing their sacred song.
